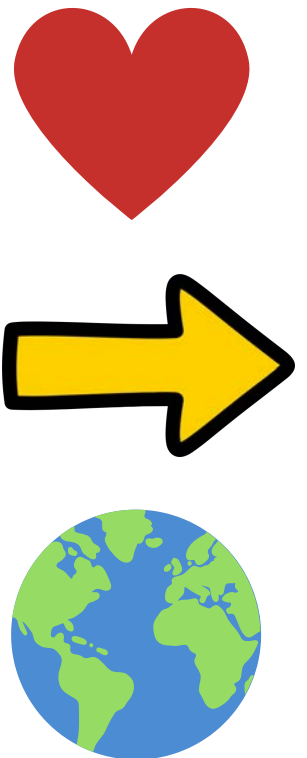

Over the course of five clinics, we had the privilege of serving the communities of Calatrava and Paghumayan in the Philippines. From babies to senior adults, every person who came for care experienced not only medical treatment but also the love and compassion of Jesus through our team. As it says in Matthew 25:40, "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Those words came to life in every interaction, every prayer, and every moment of care.

Across all five clinics, a total of 348 people were ministered to, and 214 made the life-changing decision to accept Christ. That's more than just numbers, it represents lives transformed, hope restored, and hearts opened. Each person has a story, a family, and a future that has been impacted in a meaningful way. Moments like these remind us why we go, why we serve, and why this mission matters so deeply. It's a powerful testament to what can happen when faith is put into action, and a beautiful glimpse of lives being changed for eternity.
